

Dear Exhibitors of the Klubsieger-Zuchtschau 2019 in Bueckeberg,

Maybe most of you know this already, but we got the following instructions from the competent veterinary department concerning the preconditions entering the European Community with dogs. More information can be found on this web site:

In case you come from one of the extra listed countries

You need a written declaration

that the dog is not to be brought to here to be sold (traded).

And you need a health certificate

proving that the rabies vaccination was done properly.

In case you do **not** come from one of the listed countries, in addition to the requirements before you need to have a **blood test** of your dog, which shows that the vaccination against rabies was successful. This test must have been done 3 months before the entry.

We hope you can meet all this red tape preconditions and we can welcome you in Bueckeberg.
